WORKPLACE GIVING Guide for Employees



WHAT IS WORKPLACE GIVING?

Workplace Giving is a program that enables employees to make a small donation to charity each month directly from pretax dollars via company payroll.

The impact is substantial. For example, a monthly donation of \$20 will cost you approximately \$12.60 (depending on your personal ATO tax bracket) but **EON receives the full \$20**.

Even better, many employers will match staff donations, so the value of your donation **doubles to \$40** per month.

That's almost **\$500 per year**. So imagine if lots of people in your organisation were doing the same. That's what we call **making a difference.**

IT'S GREAT FOR YOU TOO!

Besides helping to 'close the gap' between the health of Aboriginal and other Australians, you will **pay less tax** as your donation will reduce your taxable income. As such, you receive the tax benefit up front, making cash flow easier and more predictable.

HOW DO YOU GET STARTED ?

It's easy! All you need to do is speak to your payroll team to find out how to sign up. Donations will automatically appear on your payment summary, and you can start, change or stop your payments anytime - just let your payroll team know.

There is no minimum or maximum payment and it won't affect the way your gross income, superannuation payments or fringe benefits are worked out.

You can also sign up for the EON quarterly E-News so you can see how your donation is contributing to our work.
